Two men on trail for „unnatural“ sex

Your Excellency,

It is with deep concern that I have read about the detention of **Phil Mubiana** and **James Mwansa**. These two 21-year old men were arrested in the village of Ndeke (in Kapiri Mposhi) on May 6 on the grounds of real or perceived sexual orientation and have been denied bail. I believe they are currently being held at Mpima Remand Prison in Kabwe.

May I point out that the arrest of anyone for their real or perceived sexual orientation amounts to discrimination and is a violation of the rights to freedom of conscience, expression and privacy. Laws criminalising homosexuality and gender identity criminalise the legitimate exercise of these rights, which are protected in treaties ratified by Zambia, including the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights and the African Charter on Human and Peoples' Rights. Therefore, **I call for the immediate and unconditional release of these two men.**

In addition, I ask for investigations to be ordered immediately into allegations that government doctors conducted forced anal examinations of these two men. Anal examinations conducted without consent contravene the absolute prohibition of torture and other cruel, inhuman and degrading treatment or punishment under international law. If it is found there is a case to answer, I trust those responsible will be brought to trial for perpetrating acts of torture.

In the light of the above facts, I trust that you will take prompt action to ensure the immediate release of both Phil Mubiana and James Mwansa.
